### 8 June 2022 MVCSC Monthly Meeting Minutes

Secretary Lee Porter called the meeting to order at 1800. Twelve members were in attendance. Following the Pledge of Allegiance and club prayer/moment of silence for POW's and MIA's, the minutes from the May 2022 meeting were approved. Treasurer John Peck provided the most recent financial report including balances from the savings and checking accounts. A new two-stage 80 gallon air compressor was purchased .
